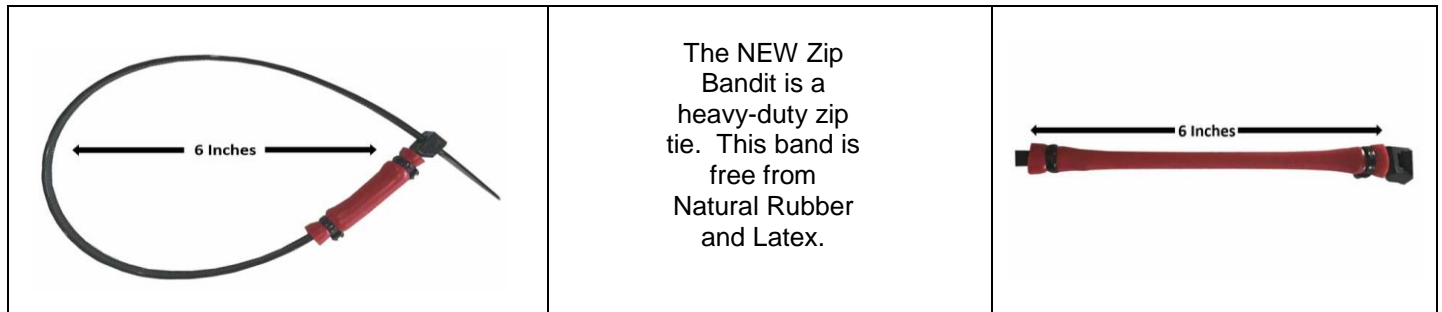


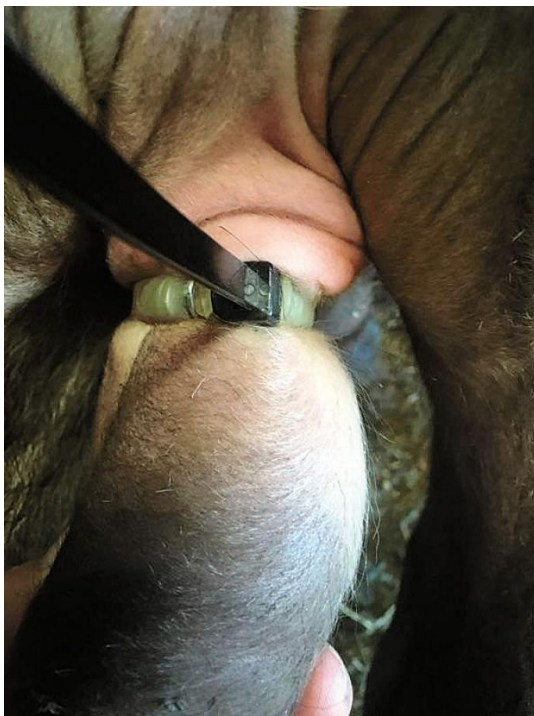
The NEW Zip Bandit Makes Castration Quicker and Easier



No expensive tools are needed to apply Zip Bandits to bulls or other animals needing castration. Just pull the Zip Bandit tight and wait for the testicles to drop off.

“We’ve used them on bulls from 300 to 750 lbs.,” say Brian Kuperus, Zip Bandit.

The Zip Bandit lead is passed around the scrotum and fed through the head. As it is pulled tight, the band stretches around the scrotum.



“It takes about 4 weeks to work on smaller animals. Perhaps because of the weight, the testicles of larger cattle take 2 ½ to 3 weeks to drop.”

Store the NEW Zip Bandit at room temperature. Consult your Veterinarian regarding Tetanus.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Start loop before slipping over testicles.
2. **Once in correct area, pull tight until the head of the Zip Bandit touches the rubber.**
3. Cut the tail of the Zip Bandit flush to prevent injury to the animal (a side cutter works best).
